DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

The Onsite Education Department at Cabrillo Marine Aquarium seeks two part-time Education Assistants for the Science at the Seashore, Sea Search classes and Aquarium Programs. As an Education Assistant, you will work with staff educators conducting marine science programming in the aquarium's exhibit hall, classroom, and in the field (tidepools, sandy beach, pier, and salt marsh) for school groups from pre-K through adult. Duties also include working public programs such as evening Grunion Runs, fairs, festivals and offsite presentations. Other roles may include: engage visitors in the Exploration Center, Exhibit Hall, and Courtyard, conduct workshops for members of the general public, assist with a variety of public fee-based and grant-funded programming and projects, develop educational programs including curricula and instructional aids, and care for and maintain live marine animals, preserved specimens and equipment used in classes and projects.

- Strong interest in working with children and in the field of Marine Biology
- Effectively communicate and engage with the general public and students of all ages
- Must be able to work well independently and as part of a collaborative team
- The ability to convey a favorable public image and guide groups of people
